To HIS EXCELLENCE THE GOVERNOR,—

The Trustees of the Australian Museum have the honor to submit to your Excellency their Fifty-first Report, for the year ended 30th June, 1905.

1. Owing to Hugh Pollock, Esq., B.A., LL.B., having ceased to hold the office of Solicitor-General, his seat as an Official Trustee lapsed.

Charles Moore, Esq., F.L.S., F.Z.S., after having held the position of an elective Trustee for twenty-five years, resigned his seat, and the Trustees regret that his death took place very shortly afterwards.

Mr. Pollock was re-elected to fill the vacancy caused by the resignation of Mr. Moore.

Professor Liversidge, M.A., F.R.S., was granted leave of absence for the year 1904 and part of 1905. T. Storie Dixson, Esq., M.B., Ch.M., was granted leave of absence for part of 1904, and Professor J. T. Wilson, M.B., Ch.M., for part of 1905.

2. Mr. H. L. Kesteven, third Mechanical Assistant, having resigned, Mr. W. A. Rainbow was engaged to succeed him.

3. The Museum continued open to visitors during the usual hours, viz., from 2 to 5 p.m. on Sundays, and from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. on all week-days, except Mondays, which were reserved for cleaning purposes; but on Monday afternoons the collections were, as usual, accessible to students and schools for teaching purposes, on application being made to the Curator. The total number of visitors recorded during 1904 was 138,388. The average was 407 on week-days, and 582 on Sundays. The largest attendance on any one day occurred on the 3rd October, when 2,767 persons entered the building.

Advantage has been taken of the "Students' Days" on Monday afternoons, students and scholars, with their teachers, having visited the Museum for study during the later months of the year to the number of 687 persons, an average of 41 each Monday during the season.

4. The Trustees have decided to carry out a scheme of Gallery Demonstrations on subjects represented in the Museum, for the benefit of Teachers and Students. The first two were held on Monday afternoons in May and June, 1905, viz., 15th May, "Sponges, from a Zoological and Commercial point of view," by Mr. Thomas Whitelegge; 12th June, "The Bower-building Birds of Australia," by Mr. A. J. North.

The course will be continued and extended.

5. The acquisition of specimens continues to be dependent on donations so far: on exchanges with other Museums, and with private collectors: on collections, the result of voluntary efforts on the part of members of the Museum staff and correspondents; and on purchases, so far as funds will permit. Details of the number of specimens so acquired will be found in Appendix IV.

The most important addition is the unique collection of specimens illustrating North Queensland Ethnology made by Dr. W. E. Roth, Protector of Aborigines for Northern Queensland, which the Trustees have acquired in its entirety.

6. The Curator again had an opportunity of visiting the Darling River District, at Murtie and Lakes Poopeloe and Wongalarra, and he was also enabled to visit the neighbourhood of Copmanhurst, Clarence River, with the authority of the Board. The result was the acquisition of numerous specimens for the Museum collections, and much valuable information.
