# Exhibition Themes

## What Are Spiders?

The visitor to *Spiders - From Fear to Fascination* is dared to enter into the world of hunting, burrowing, and weaving spiders and learn the origin of arachnids from a time before dinosaurs.

## Where Are Spiders?

The diversity of spiders is a major theme of the exhibition, and a family tree begins the journey into understanding some of the 48,000+ species from around the world.

Spiders inhabit just about every corner of the globe, and the range of habitats can be explored through touchscreens with audio visual content and interactive spider environments.

## Reproduction & Growth

Stunning, world-exclusive footage of the phenomenal three-millimeter-long (1/8th-inch-long) Peacock Spider and his mating ritual introduce the visitor to the dangerous world of spider reproduction.

## Sensing Their World

Spider auditory and visual senses are brought to life through interactive experiences, including a challenge to

listen to and identify different sounds as a spider would.

## Diet, Jaws, & Venom

How these creatures have survived millions of years all over the world is unveiled through an explanation of venom, silk, movement, vision, and vibrations. This content involves hands-on interactives, models, and live exhibits.

## Webs & Silk

Visitors learn about how spiders produce their silk and its different applications, including building a home, snaring prey, and communicating.

## Spiders & Us

Through a "Citizen Science" approach, visitors are encouraged to take their newfound knowledge to see spiders in a different light. Children and adults can also express themselves artistically, designing their own spiders, which are then projected on a large overhead screen, and brought to life with other creations across a woodland backdrop.

The latest discoveries relating to spiders, spider behavior, silk, and venom are explained with;

- Text panels

- Augmented reality experiences
