Assessment Criteria

Judges will assess each entry and make their selection based on the following five questions:

Science Communication

- 1. Did the film follow a clear and logical sequence, that was not rushed? (25%)
- 2. Did the film use relevant examples, demonstrations and/or visuals? (25%)
- 3. Did the film present accurate science and use appropriate language? (25%)

Entertainment

- 4. Did the film show that the entrant/s is passionate about their chosen topic? (15%)
- 5. Did the film include creative approaches? (10%)

While sound and image quality need to be good enough for judges to assess your entry, **production quality will not be a major consideration** in assessing entries. The Sleek Geeks Science Eureka Prize is about scientific content and communication of that content, not production values and investment.

Judges will take into consideration the **number of participants** involved in each entry to ensure that small teams and individuals are not disadvantaged. The **school year of the entrants** will also be considered.
